
Article 1 To elect a moderator to preside at said meeting.

Article 2 To see if the town will vote to apply all funds received from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the Maine Emergency Management Agency (MEMA) to the Road Maintenance Account. The funds will be received from disaster # 4719 for the events on May 1, 2023 and disaster # 4754 for the events on December 17, 2023. The funds received will be used to rebuild roads back to pre-storm condition and improvements.




